



Information on enrollment in the first year of study for citizens from non-EU countries

Enrollment Slots

Enrollment slots for the current academic year are published on the website of the Ministry of Education, on the website <https://studyinslovenia.si> and on the websites of the faculties of the University of Novo mesto.

Citizens of non-EU countries can apply for **enrollment slots designated for foreigners – citizens of non-EU countries**.

Application and enrollment period

Application period for Slovenians without Slovenian citizenship and for foreign citizens:

1. 5. 2025 – 31. 8. 2025.

An application that has been completed and submitted electronically to [eVŠ](#) by the application deadline is considered to have been submitted on time. All required attachments must also be submitted by the application deadline.

Enrollment period for Slovenians without Slovenian citizenship and foreign citizens:

1. 9. 2025 – 30. 9. 2025.



The application procedure

The candidate submits an application for enrollment via an electronic application on the eVŠ web portal:
<https://portal.evs.gov.si/prijava/?locale=en>

Applicants can choose one of the following application methods:

- with an electronic means of identification of at least medium reliability (with a qualified digital certificate, smsPASS, e-identity card),
- AAI account (authentication and authorization infrastructure account),
- username and password via the SI-PASS system operating within the State Center for Trust Services.

In the first step of the electronic application for enrollment, the candidate selects:

- Select nationality: **Select the country of your nationality.**
- Level of study: **First level**
- **Public higher education institutions and concessions**
- Call for enrollment: **CALL FOR ENROLLMENT FOR UNDERGRADUATE AND SIMPLE MASTER'S DEGREES – University of Ljubljana, University of Maribor, University of Primorska, University of Nova Gorica, University of Novo mesto, New University, public and concessioned independent higher education institutions**
- Application periods: choose the application period starting with the name of the higher education institution (university, faculty) offering the study programme you wish to enroll in
- Type of application: **1st year enrollment**

Proof of fulfilment of the admission requirements

Applicants who have completed secondary school abroad must submit all required documents electronically via the eVŠ portal:

- **Proof of the content and duration of completed education and fulfilled obligations** (e-copy or photo of documents showing the content and duration of education and fulfilled obligations during education),
- **Chronological description of already completed education abroad** (e-copy or photo of a brief chronological description of the entire education),
- **Certificate of completed education abroad** (e-copy or photo of documents on completed education, without legalization),
- **Personal identification document with written consent of the applicant** (page with personal details such as surname, first name, date and place of birth and nationality),
- **Translation of the documents on the completed education abroad** (e-copy or photo of a court-certified translation of the documents from point 1 into Slovenian or English),
- **Adequate proof of Slovenian language proficiency at B2 level** (e-copy or photo of proof of passing the Slovenian language exam at the appropriate level or other relevant proof).

Language

The pedagogical process is conducted in **Slovenian**.

Applicants are expected to have **knowledge of the Slovenian language at B2 level** according to the European language scale of the CEFR.



Tuition fee

Foreign nationals who are **citizens of an EU Member State and citizens of countries with which the Republic of Slovenia has concluded bilateral or multilateral agreements on cooperation in the field of education or on reciprocity** (Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Serbia) **are exempt from tuition fees** for foreigners for full-time study programmes with a concession for Slovenian citizens.

Tuition fees for **part-time studies and for non-discounted study programmes** are paid by all students. Tuition fees are set by the higher education institution with a price list for the current academic year.

Compulsory health insurance is not included in the tuition fees. Insurance must be arranged before the start of your studies.
